Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How many players should I have?

A: Most teams operate with at least 10 players. If you have any less you may find it difficult to field a team.

Q: Is there mandatory playing time rules for players?

A: There are no mandatory playing time rules.

Q: How to submit a schedule request?

Game requests must be submitted at least 14 days prior to the event start date and must be submitted on the Request Form located on your account dashboard.

Team members are not authorized to take requests, to be considered you must submit on the request form located on your account dashboard.

We make every effort to accommodate each and every request, but it's simply not always possible so we never guarantee in advance a request will be approved. We do recommend planning appropriately around tournament start times, which vary by season and can be adjusted based on the amount of teams.

Q: What age groups does War at the Shore Baseball offer?

We offer 7u, 8u, 9u, 10u, 11u, 12u, 13u, 14u, 15u, 16u, JV, & Varsity. 10u teams will have the option to play on the 46/60 or the 46/65 diamond. 11u teams will have the option to play on the 46/60 or the 50/70 diamond. 12u teams will play on the 50/70 diamond in the Spring & Summer. All teams will play the following years age group in the fall. For example a 12u team from the summer will have the option to play 13u 60/90 or 13u 50/70 in the fall. 13u will also have the 50/70 option the following spring.

Q: How do I know what team age my team will be?

Players must be born on or after May 1st. For 2025 the ages cutoffs are :

05/01/07	18u	05/01/13	12u
05/01/08	17u	05/01/14	11u
05/01/09	16u	05/01/15	10u
05/01/10	15u	05/01/16	9u
05/01/11	14u	05/01/17	8u

League age is the age the player has attained prior to May 1 of the playing season. Example: A player who is ten years old at the beginning of the season but will turn eleven on or before April 30 shall be classified as League Age 11. Players may not "play up" (participate) in competitive leagues higher than their league age level, regardless of their skill level.

School age exemptions: ONLY TWO school grade exemptions per team will be allowed for players of the same graduating year who were born prior to May 1st. However, those players must be born on/after January 1 to be eligible. Players must be only rostered on the team looking for the exemption. Players cannot be on any other team except for intramurals.

Q: When will the schedule be posted?

Games usually will be played on weekends in the Spring and Fall. The Summer Leagues will have games on any day you wish to play. We pride ourselves on accommodating our team's needs. After a schedule is posted, teams have 10 days to changes if they wish. After that point the schedule is finalized with no changes except for weather.

Q: How far will I have to travel?

A: Schedules are posted on our website after 5 PM the Tuesday prior to the tournament.

Q: How do I rate my team?

Elite Rating: You are a strong "A" level team and can challenge any team with confidence.

A Rating: You are an "A" level team. You have an All-Star Caliber team. You are competitive with most A teams.

B Rating: You are a "B" level team. You have some strong players and some weak ones.

C Rating: You should be a weaker "B" level team or a stronger "C" level team. You have at least one pitcher that is decent.

D Rating: You should have a very weak team. D rated teams would be compared to rec teams.

How to use a Tournament Credit:

Register for Tournament

Enter the reason for the credit in the comments box when you register.

Tournament credits can only be applied to the tournament fee.

Tournament credits are valid for one year from the original event date, they are non-refundable for cash and non-transferable outside of your organization.

How Do I use a Credit from a previous Tournament?

Register for the Tournament of your choosing.

Email us info@warattheshoretournaments.org and include the event the Tournament credit was issued and we will adjust your invoice accordingly.

Please note that credits are good for ONE YEAR and only apply to the Tournament Fee

Does our team need its own insurance?

Yes. Each team must provide a copy of their liability insurance at registration via the website.

Please contact your insurance company and ask for a copy of the "Certificate of Liability". Teams will not be allowed to play without this.

Do teams need to bring baseballs?

Game balls are provided by War at the Shore, they will be picked up at check-in. Teams should bring their own practice balls.

When will the game results be posted?

Game results are posted in our system as the game scores are received. The standings automatically update live on our website and our Welcome Center has printouts of each age bracket posted as well.

I am a parent and I have a question that is not listed here, who should I call for more information?

Parents should contact their coaches for more information about the tournament and email us for any other assistance.
